

# Liquid Laundry Soap

Makes 5 Gallons

---

## Gather

- 5 Gallon bucket with lid
- 4 cups hot tap water
- 1 cup Arm & Hammer Super Washing Soda
- 1/2 cup Oxiclean Free
- 2 cups baking soda
- 1 bar pure castile soap, grated
- 5 capfuls Thieves Household Cleaner
- 3 tbsp. Mrs. Stewart's Bluing Agent

## Directions

1. Grate soap and set aside
2. Pour hot tap water into saucepan and add grated soap, stirring gently over LOW heat until the soap has melted.
3. Fill a 5 gallon bucket half full of hot tap water and add the melted soap mixture, washing soda, baking soda, Oxiclean Free, and the Thieves Household Cleaner.
4. Stir well until all the powder is dissolved,
5. Fill the 5 gallon bucket to just below the top. Cover and let sit overnight to thicken.
6. Add blueing agent.

Use 1 oz for HE washing machines

Use 3 oz for standard machines

Note:

Don't be alarmed if the detergent seems thinner than conventional detergents. There are no binders or fillers so it won't be thick like store-bought detergents.

I found my 5 gallon bucket with a lid at Home Depot.

Depending on where you live you may need to sub out some of the ingredients. We don't have Mrs. Stewart's bluing agent in Canada, so I bought mine from Amazon. I also bought a type of Oxiclean free, found in the natural cleaning section of my grocery store.
